1. Preamble:-

The school is managed and owned by The Malankara Catholic Diocese of Pathanamthitta. One of the primary apostolates of the Diocese of Pathanamthitta is its service in the field of education. For the last 92 years, the Church has been rendering excellent services to the society by providing quality education to thousands of students. Its goal in its educational undertakings has always been something more than the ordinary, something more than the mediocre. Through its educational institutions the Diocese has tried to reach out to all sections of the society, at the same time without compromising on quality, values and excellence. The educational programme of the Diocese of Pathanamthitta is guided by the principles and the universal values of the Gospels.

Mar Ivanios Central School, Vadaserikkara is set in sylvan surroundings accessible from any part of the town as well as reachable from all villages in Vadasserikara. The School aims at the enrichment of the minds, improvement of physique, the glorification of the spirit, the inculcation of value and the refinement of attitudes and emotions in our children.

2. Patron

His Excellency Samuel Mar Ireneos, the Bishop of Pathanamthitta is the patron of the school. There are many schools under the ownership of the Diocese of Pathanamthitta. Mainly CBSE and State Syllabus Schools functioning both in the aided and unaided sectors. The School functions under the Malankara Catholic Educational Society, which is a registered society for the unaided CBSE schools.



3. Objectives

The school provides each student with the best education possible based on the fundamental human values. Each student is helped to develop a wholesome personality for which due emphasis is given in the curriculum for intellectual, physical, moral and spiritual growth. A sense of social awareness and responsibility is created in the growing child, making him/her self-reliant. The programme of education implemented in this school aims at, forming worthy citizens, who are committed to the sublime values of our nation.

4. Motto

The motto of the school is "To learn for Light and Love"

5. Course offered

The Medium of instruction is English and the students are expected to converse only in English within the school campus. Malayalam and Hindi are compulsory languages for standards I to VII.

6. Co-Curricular Activities

In order to enable the students to achieve the integration of education and cultural values with a true philosophy of life, the school provides ample opportunities to the students for co-curricular activities through the literary Club, Science Club, Yoga, Karate, Instrumental Music, Quiz, Arts, Sports, Games and Study Tours.

7. Academic Year

The Academic Year starts in June and ends in March. All public holidays are holidays for the school. Termly holidays are given during Onam, Christmas and Mid Summer. Further details are given in the Calendar.



8. Admission

- a. Admissions to Play school & L.K.G classes for the succeeding Academic year is given in December of the previous year. Application forms and prospectus are issued from the office in November of the previous year.
- b. The Principal reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason.
- c. The minimum age for admission to Play school is 2 1/2 Years LKG class is 3 1/2 Years and to standard 1 is 5 1/2 Year on the first of June of the year of study. The age limit varies correspondingly for admission to other standards Note: Relaxation to the age limits will not be granted.
- d. Admission to all classes other than LKG is strictly restricted to the number of vacancies arising in each class every year. Separate application forms will be issued for such admissions and the selection test will be conducted on the date announced at the end of every academic year.
- e. Students seeking admission from other states or countries should produce Transfer Certificates countersigned by competent educational authorities of the particular State.

9. Withdrawals or Removal

- a. Advance application signed by the parents or guardian is required for withdrawing a student from the school.
 - b. If the pupil is admitted to or withdrawn from the school in the middle of a term, tuition fee for the whole year should be paid.
 - c. Transfer certificate will be issued only after all dues are cleared and all books are returned to the library.
 - d. The Principal may ask a parent/guardian to withdraw a child, if the
-



child does not comply with the discipline of the school or is incapable of coping up with the curriculum.

- e. Students can be removed from the school for any one of the following:
- ◆ Constant weakness in studies
 - ◆ Irregularity in attendance
 - ◆ Behavioural problems
 - ◆ Over age in class
 - ◆ Non payment of fee or chronic irregularity in payment of fees
 - ◆ Moral breach considered seriously by the school committee

10. Examinations

- a. There will be four formative examinations and two summative examinations a year, other than regular tests. LKG and UKG will have only three terminal examinations.
- b. Each termly Examination will be based on portions taught till that examination from the beginning of the academic year.
- c. Parents are advised to watch the progress of their children very closely, consult the teachers and take their advice whenever necessary.
- d. All answer papers of all examinations (except the final exam) will be sent to the parents for their scrutiny, signature and return. This gives the parents sufficient opportunity to assess the performance of their ward.
- e. Suitable changes in the mode and pattern of examinations will be made when found necessary. Such changes will be intimated to the students in advance.

11. Promotion

- a. Promotion to a higher class is based on a student's overall performance in the various examinations conducted during the year. Please see the Progress Report Card for details.
-

- b. Results are declared at the end of every academic year and are final in all cases. Results will be withheld if
 - (a) The student fails in one subject
 - (b) Fees are not paid for all the 12 months of the year.
Note: Requests for review of the results will not be entertained.
- c. The promotion lists will be put on the School notice board. Results will not be communicated to the parents or students by any other means.
- d. Students who fail to score 40 % average in each subject will be detained.
- e. A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue studies in the school.
- f. There is no provision for re-examination.
- g. A student without 80% attendance during the academic year is liable to be detained.

12. Absence and Leaves

- a. Regular attendance at school is the prime requisite for progress in study. Parents are to ensure that their child does not absent himself/herself from school without valid reason.
 - b. Permission for absence must be obtained before taking leave for any reason other than illness or emergency. A written application must be submitted to the class teacher for permission, preferably in this Diary.
 - c. When a student returns to school after a period of unexpected absence, he/she must have the reason for absence certified in the diary by the guardian or parents.
 - d. If the absence is likely to prolong owing to illness extending over 5 days the matter should be communicated to the principal along with a medical certificate.
-



- e. Absenting on the first day after holidays or for examinations will be viewed seriously.
- f. Continuous absence for 15 days or more without leave, will render a pupil liable to be removed from the roll. Re- admission, if granted, will be made only after the payment of fresh admission fees.

13. School Uniform

It is compulsory that every student shall wear the school uniforms on all working days. However, they can put on colour dresses on their birthdays.

14. Discipline

- a. The School insists on punctuality, regular attendance, good manners, cleanliness and devotion to study. Above all the student must be courteous to superiors and fellow students (Please see the section; Guidelines to Good manners).
 - b. Every student shall bring the text books and note books required for the classes neatly covered and labelled. No newspapers, periodicals or pictures shall be brought to school. No mobile phones and CDs or DVDs are allowed. Violation of which will lead to expulsion from the school.
 - c. Every student is required to help maintain the school premises clean and tidy. Waste paper and other waste materials should be deposited in the bins provided for the purpose. Defacing of walls, destruction of furniture, tampering with the plants in the garden etc. will be severely dealt with.
 - d. All assignments shall be regularly done and submitted. Parents/ guardians are requested to read the REMARK section of the School Diary of their ward every day.
-

- e. Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their books and other belongings. No valuable articles or money should be brought to school. Sharp instruments and tools are not allowed in the school premises.
 - f. Students must move along the corridors and veranda in absolute silence and in an orderly manner. While moving along the classes or halls, they are to keep left and move in the line.
 - g. Students who remain in their class rooms during intervals are not allowed to play in the corridors or in the school yard during intervals.
 - h. In the absence of a teacher, it is the class prefect's responsibility to keep order in the class. Strict silence should be observed inside the class during such times.
 - i. Students will converse only in English while they are in the School Campus.
 - j. Students are not allowed to leave the School premises during class time without written permission of the class teacher or Principal. They should never have any contact with strangers on their way to or back from the school.
 - k. If any student is found sick or wounded, the matter should be immediately reported to any of the teachers for immediate attention.
 - l. All students are expected to strictly follow the instructions given by the class teacher through the Prefect/ Class Leaders.
 - m. Student travelling by the school buses should queue when they board the buses.

15. Prefects

A team of senior students has been carefully chosen and appointed as prefects. They will be in charge of the general discipline inside the campus and will assist in the conduct of the extra curricular activities of the school. The prefects will be provided with identification badges and all the students of the school are expected to follow the directions and instructions given by the prefects.

16. School Buses

Our school buses run to different parts of the city. Check with the the School office for bus routes and stops. The students can travel by school bus only after remitting the bus fee and obtaining Journey Card from the School office. Note the following points as safety measure.

- a. See that the school bags are soft and secure enough to be taken in the buses.
 - b. While in the bus, do not stretch your hand or head out of the bus, and never make any noise.
 - c. Guardians should ensure that children board the bus safely and are taken back on their return.
 - d. Students who travel by school bus should always carry the Journey Card with them.
 - e. When the student stops using the School bus, the matter should be reported to the office and the Journey Card returned, failing which the bus fee for the whole year will have to be paid.
 - f. Get into the bus in a queue and be quiet inside the bus.
 - g. Offer your seat to someone who needs it more than you do.
 - h. Follow the instructions of the bus Staff and the bus Guides.
-

- i. Bus fee should be paid directly at the office. It should not be handed to the bus staff for payment. The school will not be responsible if it is lost.

17. Good Behaviour

- a. Good behaviour is an expression of the character.
- b. Be neat and modest in your dress and manners.
- c. Courtesy begets courtesy. Use the word 'Please', "Thank you" and "Sorry" as often as possible.
- d. Be polite, obliging and helpful. Be careful not to hurt anyone with your words or actions.
- e. Be a cheerful giver, you will help to create a beautiful world.

18. A Word to the Parents/Guardians

In educating a child, the parents/guardians and teachers have to co-operate with and compliment each other. Here are a few helpful suggestions.

- a. Kindly make use of this Diary: Valuable comments from teachers will be written on the page of the Diary marked Teacher's Remarks.
- b. Please do attend the P.T.A meeting regularly. You will be able to meet teachers during those days and discuss your child's progress with them.
- c. Please visit the teachers during the intervals only if very necessary. Lunch break is ideal.
- d. Please remember that a disciplined child at home will be a disciplined child at School. Take interest in their tests, assignments, and their daily work and also in their extra curricular activities.
- e. Tuitions are not to be encouraged.



- f. Please do not harass your child, abuse or punish them when they fail short of your expectations in academic performance. Try to encourage and instil confidence in them. Please try to examine if YOU are in any way responsible for the backwardness of your child.
- g. Kindly avoid criticising the teachers in the presence of your Children.
- h. Please do not believe everything your children tell you about the teachers or the School. Children are very imaginative and they cook up stories to escape punishments.
- i. If you have genuine complaints please do not hesitate to contact the teachers directly or bring the matters to the notice of the School authorities.
- j. When you find your child incapable of managing the CBSE syllabus, be wise enough to put them in the State syllabus. They will show remarkable improvement.

SOME IMPORTANT SUGGESTIONS TO THE PARENTS OF KINDERGARTEN CHILDREN (LKG & UKG)

1. Dress your children neatly but sufficiently in loose and comfortable dress. Let the socks be clean, shoes polished and comfortable.
2. Avoid gold or silver ornaments totally.
3. Identification tags may be attached to all the belongings of the children. (Bags, Towels, water bottles etc.)



4. Please send limited quantity of food which the child likes.
5. Teachers should be informed if problem, minor or major.
6. It will be useful if you send a set of casual wear too.
7. If the child travels by School bus please take the child a few minutes early to the boarding point. Send only responsible people to accompany the child and to collect the child back from the boarding point. Parents must provide authorization letter with photograph of the receiver.
8. There is a first-aid room in the School to give medical aid to children. Whenever necessary, parents will be informed. In an emergency the child will be hospitalized.
9. Look at this Diary every day for Teacher's Remarks.

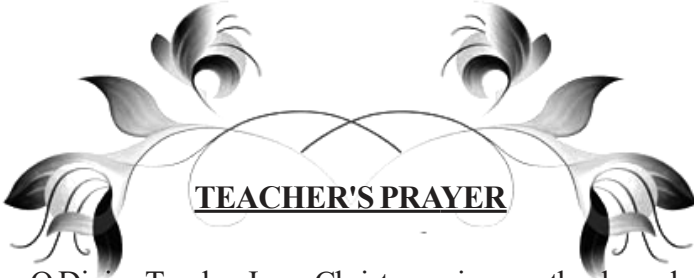

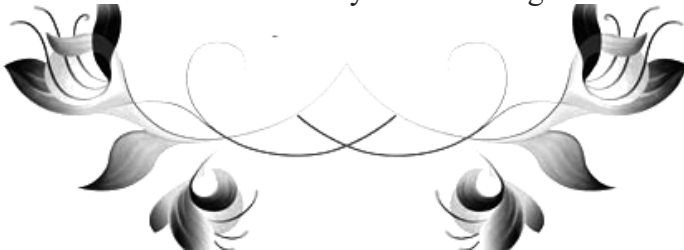
TEACHER'S PRAYER
